2. m2e is developing a website where members can become involved in online various activities as explained in document "m2e Ai01" (the "Answers Document"). This is a free service and every member also becomes a shareholder in m2e.
3. You are a member and a shareholder of m2e. Upon accepting this agreement we will activate additional benefits as outlined in document "m2e Ri02" (the "Ripple Membership"). This is a passive role, but upon acceptance you may also introduce other people to the Ripple Membership and receive additional benefits as described in the Ripples Membership document.
4. If you are in any doubt as to the terms and conditions of this agreement you are recommended to take independent legal advice before proceeding. Headings are for reference purposes only and in no way define, limit, construe or describe the scope or extent of such section.
5. When you accept that you have read the agreement, the terms and conditions becoming binding between you and m2e. Following acceptance we will immediately begin to process your order, creating the additional benefits described in the Ripple Membership document.

### Recruitment of Members

6. You may also recruit new members using marketing material and methods approved by m2e.
7. When promoting m2e you MUST NOT send unsolicited online messages (SPAM) to anyone you do not know. You must not offend anyone or provide misleading information. You must observe any direct marketing laws that exist in your country or state. You may advertise but you agree to disclose your planned campaign to m2e first, in writing and wait until we give our agreement in writing before you book anything.
8. You must promote m2e in an ethical way and should you at any time during the promotion of m2e bring m2e into disrepute, whether intentional or otherwise, we reserve the right to terminate this agreement and take additional legal action against you.
9. You may not sub-licence this agreement without our written consent.

### Payment of fees

10. The fee to activate your Ripple Membership is to be paid as per the order form. The payment options will be given on the order form.
11. Your benefits under the Ripple Membership are activated only when we receive cleared funds in our bank account. You may cancel this agreement in writing only at any time, for any reason within 7 days and receive a full refund. After this time you may still cancel the agreement, but refunds are only issued at m2e's discretion and in all cases become subject to a cancellation fee of GBP £12.00.

### Support

12. If you wish to recommend any new m2e member, m2e will give you suitable assistance by email and telephone.
13. m2e will provide you with all the necessary documents, website

resources, advertisement formats and business stationery required by you (at cost) if you wish to recommend the business of m2e to other people.

14. m2e will endeavour to answer as soon as practicable any enquiries concerning the business of m2e.

### Payment of Benefits

15. Upon the 3000<sup>th</sup> member joining m2e we shall allocate you additional shares as described in the Ripple Membership document.
16. When the full-feature website launches we shall seek freelance Customer Care Managers ("CCMs") who will be responsible for finding Business Members. We shall assign you to a number of CCMs as per the Ripple Membership document and give you a commission over-ride on all sales of annual Business Member contracts they make. If your CCMs do not perform well, we will transfer you to a better performing CCM to increase your commission.
17. Payments will be made as per your wishes which will be communicated to us when you are assigned to your CCMs.

### Tax and Your Additional Responsibilities

18. You acknowledge that at all times whilst representing m2e you must act in an ethical and responsible manner, observing and respecting the confidentiality paragraphs of this agreement and refrain from any activity that might bring m2e into disrepute.
19. You are responsible for obtaining all necessary permits, additional licences and insurances as required under local law to perform your services under this agreement. You are also responsible for the payment of all applicable government taxes and for all social security and other similar tax in connection with the performance your services under this agreement.
20. You are responsible for the payment of all expenses, business or otherwise, and the costs of finding new members should you wish to do this. You are also responsible for keeping your personal contact details up to date at all times.
21. You shall act as an independent contractor and shall not consider yourself an agent or employee of m2e.
22. You agree that disclosure of any taxable income is your own responsibility and you are recommended by m2e to take appropriate legal, accounting or tax advice connected to your activities with m2e.
23. Where required by court order m2e will assist any recognised authority from any jurisdiction in any investigation into any of its citizens where criminal activity is believed to have taken place.

### Termination & Disputes

24. If this agreement is terminated for whatever reason (including but not limited to personal decision, penalty under paragraph 8, breach ill-health, loss of internet connection, bankruptcy, death or natural disaster) m2e will seek to pay all outstanding benefits to you within 30-days of such termination taking place.
25. On termination of this agreement for whatever reasons you shall at the request of m2e promptly return all documentation in your possession or control relating to the business activities and affairs of the Company as applicable.
26. If any dispute or difference arises out of or in connection with this Agreement the parties shall seek to resolve the dispute or



difference amicably by using an alternative dispute resolution (ADR) procedure acceptable to both parties before pursuing any other remedies available to them. If any party fails or refuses to agree to or participate in the ADR procedure or if in any event the dispute or difference is not resolved to the satisfaction of both parties within 90 days after it has arisen the dispute or difference shall be referred to arbitration.

#### Period of Agreement

27. This agreement shall remain in force until cancelled legitimately by either party.

#### Warranties and Indemnities

28. You agree that you will not during the term of this agreement or at any time following its termination use any Confidential Information for your own benefit or for the benefit of any other person except as permitted under the terms of this agreement. Nothing in this agreement will prevent you from using such information as may have come into the public domain through no fault of your own or breach of this agreement.
29. You agree to indemnify m2e against all costs or demands which may be made against it by any person arising out of breach of this Agreement as made by you.
30. You agree to comply with m2e's trademarks, service marks and brand guidelines and agree not do anything to infringe or damage these.
31. You agree not to work for or accept instructions during the term of this agreement from any third party organisation in direct competition with m2e. You agree to notify m2e in writing if they believe that your performance of this Agreement would conflict with the interest of any of your existing clients.
32. You agree to act in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations governing the use of personal information or data as may exist in your country. You also agree not make any public or private comments relating to m2e or the work undertaken for m2e without the prior written permission of m2e.

#### Waiver

33. No delay or failure by either party to exercise any of its powers, rights or remedies under this Agreement will operate as a waiver of them, nor will any single or partial exercise of any such powers, rights or remedies preclude any other or further exercise of them. Any waiver to be effective must be in writing. The remedies provided in this Agreement are cumulative and not exhaustive of any remedies provided by law.

#### Confidential Information and Non Disclosure

34. Both you and m2e agree to respect each others' Confidential Information (technical, personal, commercial, financial, operational, marketing or promotional information, relationships or data). Neither you nor m2e shall disclose the other party's Confidential Information to anyone who is not authorised by the other to receive it.

35. Both Parties irrevocably agree and guarantee each other they shall not directly or indirectly interfere with; circumvent or attempt to circumvent any pre-existing relationships between the Parties and their respective clients, members, research partners, suppliers, manufacturers, brokers, distributors, agents, financiers, accountants, bankers, legal counsel, shareholders or license providers in any nation or state.

#### Limitation of Liability

36. Neither party will be liable to the other for any direct or indirect damages, lost profits, lost business or anticipated savings, whether actual or reasonably foreseen. Both parties agree that the limitations and exclusions of liability set out in this paragraph are reasonable and take into consideration the commercial value of this agreement to both parties and the commercial standing of both parties.

#### Force Majeure

37. Neither party shall be liable for delay or failure to perform any obligation under this Agreement if the delay or failure is caused by any circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to Acts of God, war, civil disorder or industrial disputes. If such delay or failure continues for a period of at least Sixty (60) days the party not subject to the force majeure shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement by written notice to the other.

#### General

38. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the Laws of England and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
39. IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that the foregoing paragraphs, sub paragraphs and Paragraphs of this Agreement shall be read and construed independently of each other. Should any part of this Agreement or its paragraphs, sub paragraphs or Paragraphs be found invalid it shall not affect the remaining paragraphs, sub paragraphs and Paragraphs.
40. Failure by either party to enforce any accrued rights under this Agreement is not to be taken as or deemed to be a waiver of those rights unless the waiving party acknowledges the waiver in writing.
41. This agreement sets out the entire agreement and understanding of the parties and is in substitution of any previous written or oral agreement between the parties.
42. We reserve the right to update this agreement at any time without prior warning, unless such changes will detrimentally affect your membership in a severe manner.
43. You are reminded to take legal advice and to use your own best judgement in any lending you participate in on m2e.
